I am a victim of sexual exploitation
by a procurer or a human trafficking network.

I am looking for a way out

The Pathway out of Prostitution (PSP) lasts for **6 months, renewable 3 times** (up to 24 months), and gives me access to **training, a job, financial aid and a temporary residence permit** (APS) within the framework of an **overall social support package**.

HOW CAN I FIND ALTERNATIVES TO PROSTITUTION?

- I must be **accompanied by an approved association** which will help me to prepare my application for a PSP: Amicale du Nid is approved in all the departments in which it operates ([list](#)),
- With the support of a professional from the approved association, I **prepare my application**, with a complete file, which will be sent to the members of the departmental committee who will examine the application,
- **The application will be submitted to the departmental committee** by the approved association supporting me,
- **The committee will either approve or reject** my request,
- **The Prefect will decide** whether to accept or refuse the application.

WHAT ARE MY RIGHTS IF I AM ON A PATHWAY OUT OF PROSTITUTION?

- I will receive **comprehensive social support** to help me integrate into society and the workplace,
- Subject to my existing resources I could qualify for **Financial Support for Social and Occupational Integration** (AFIS), which provides €343/month for one person, and €432 for people with a dependent child (at 30/06/2024),
- If I have no administrative rights, I may be granted a **Temporary residence permit** (APS) for 6 months, renewable 3 times for up to 2 years.

WHAT ARE THE CONDITIONS FOR BENEFITING FROM THE PATHWAY OUT OF PROSTITUTION?

- **Stopping prostitution**
- **Social and occupational integration**
- **Respect for public order**
